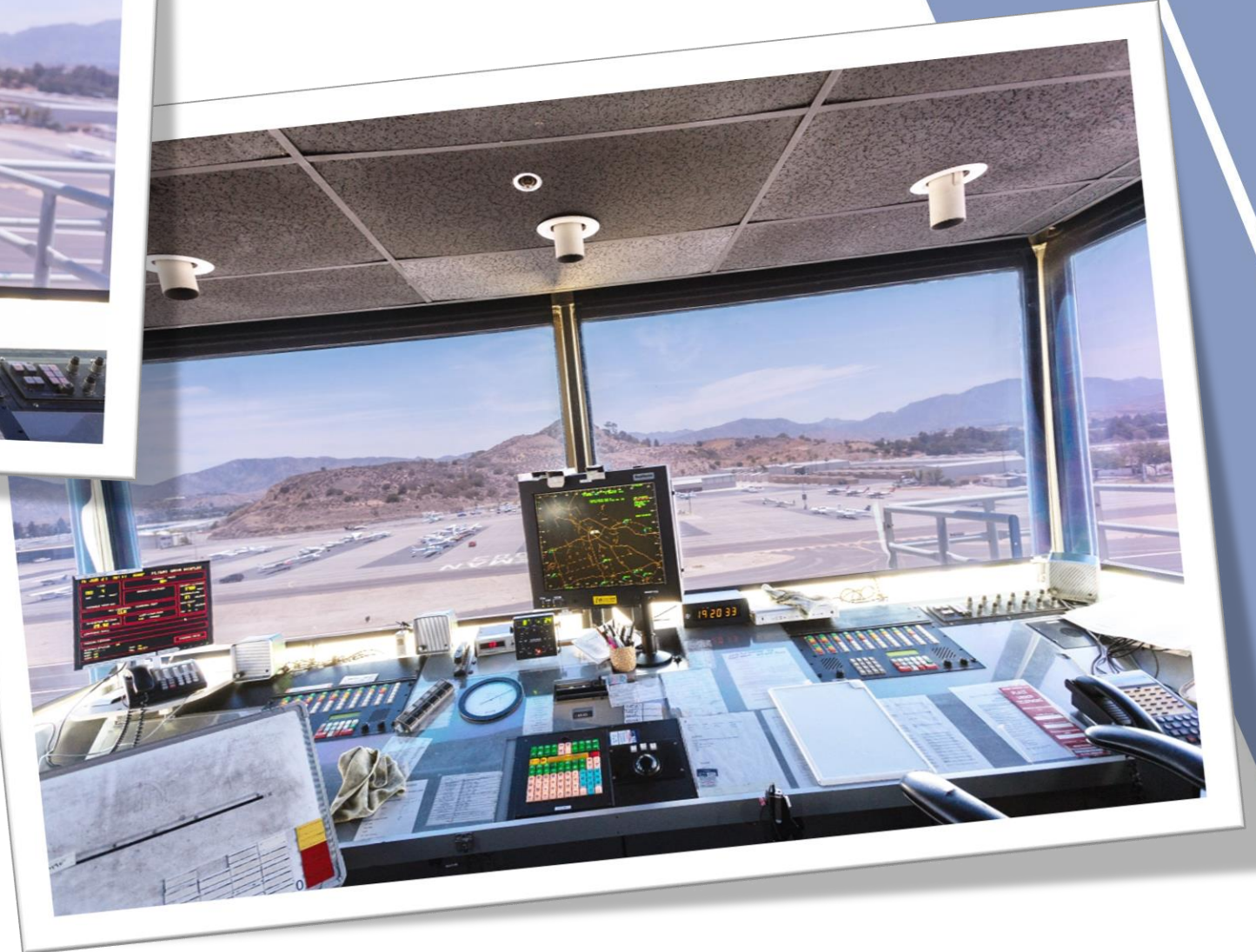




















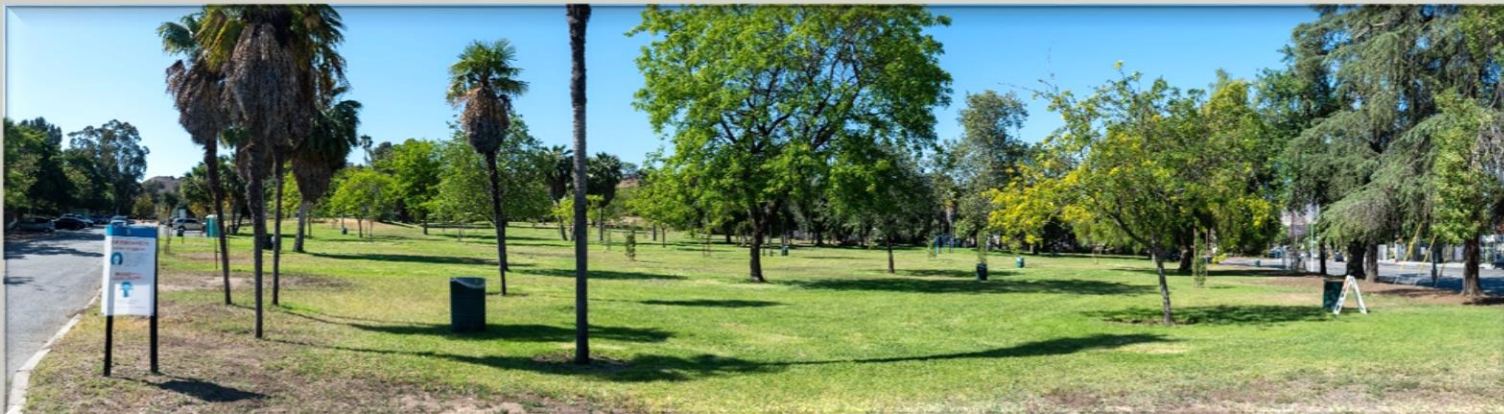
Re-envisioning Plan Overview

Overview & Intent

- ♦ To develop a community informed re-envisioning plan for the airport.
 - *Includes baseline assessments of environmental resources and community outreach to identify objectives that will reduce environmental impacts, realize economic benefits, and improve community relations.*
- ♦ The CAC and the community will provide input and help drive the Plan.

Sustainability Management Plan Overview

*Comprehensive sustainability planning for airports utilize “**baseline assessments of environmental resources and community outreach** to identify sustainability objectives”, focus areas and “**initiatives for reducing environmental impacts, achieving economic benefits, and increasing integration with local communities,**” according to the FAA.*
